The tournament site has been paid for. It will be held at Montezuma Neighborhood Park located at 4800 Catoctin Drive, San Diego, CA 92115. The feast tokens are being made, they are going to be Troll statuettes (and are currently marching across my kitchen table). Anyone who would like to assist in painting these is more than welcome. I have all the paints and supplies. We are currently looking into small metal gargoyle charms for tournament site tokens. I am still looking for someone to do gate, and would like an accurate count of Members vs. Non-members (of the SCA) who attend the meeting. The site fee we are thinking about is \$4.00 day fee for Non-Members and \$2.00 for members. The feast fee is still being calculated but will be somewhere between \$6.00 and \$8.00. We will be requesting an insurance certificate for the park from Mistress Alesia at Baronial Council meeting on February 20, 2002.
